



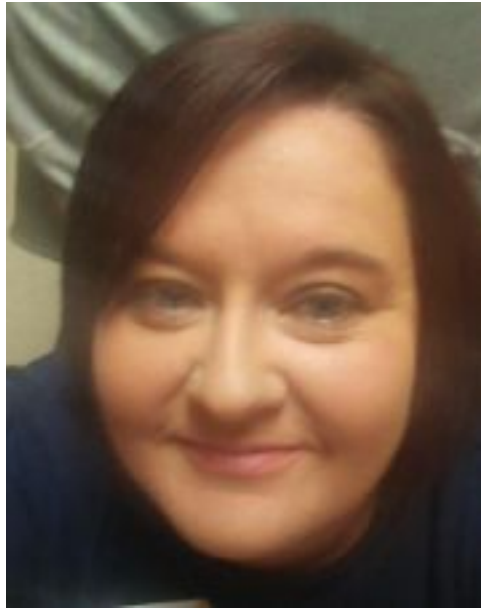

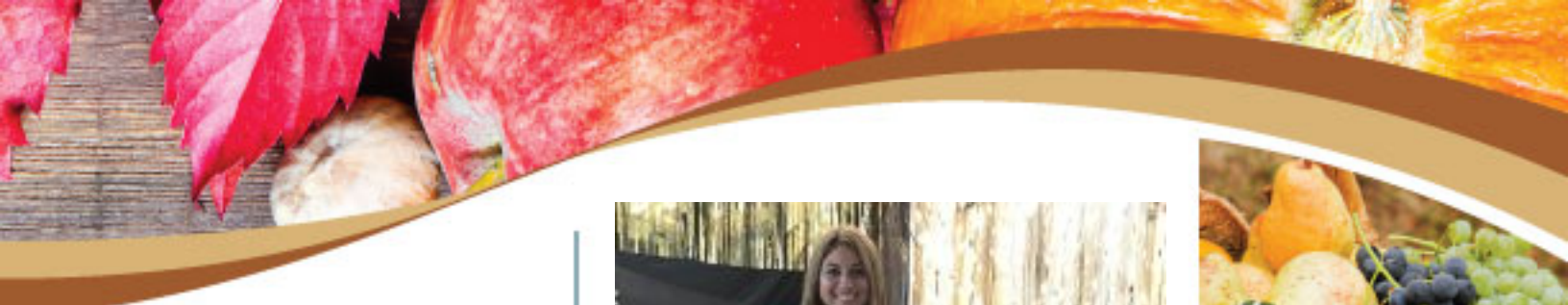


Etiquette Rules
